COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 935, L D 1439, "An Act to Promote Family-centered Interventions for Substance Use Disorder Treatment"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1728 is enacted to read.

§1728. Substance use disorder treatment information

A hospital licensed under chapter 405 shall post in a publicly accessible area of its emergency department information provided by the department that describes how individuals with substance use disorder can access evidence-based treatment services

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made

**HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF
Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Z199**

Initiative Provides one-time funding for grants to support substance use disorder treatments that include family members of the person with substance use disorder, including community reinforcement and family training interventions

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 935, L D 1439

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SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. It requires a hospital to post in a publicly accessible area of its emergency department information provided by the Department of Health and Human Services regarding how individuals with substance use disorder can access evidence-based treatment services. It adds an appropriations and allocations section providing \$30,000 in one-time grant funds to support substance use disorder treatments that include family members of the person with substance use disorder, including community reinforcement and family training interventions.
