## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Increasing the maximum amount of total loans from the School Revolving Renovation Fund for repairs, renovati, and improvement projects for school buildings that may be outstanding at one time from \$4 0 million to \$8 0 million will increase the amount of funding available for eligible priority projects According to the Department of Education, the current balance in the Fund is \$7 824 million Increasing the maximum loan amount for each priority project from \$1 0 million to \$2 0 million may reduce the number of projects that can be funded

Additional costs to the Maine Municipal Bond Bank and the Department of Education associated with rule making can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources
