SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 597, L D 1477, "RESOLUTION, Proposing
9 an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Align the Proceedings for Circulating
10 Written Petitions for People's Vetoes and Direct Initiatives with Federal Law"

Amend the resolution by striking out the question (page 2, lines 14 to 16 in L D) and
12 inserting the following

13

' "Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to remove a provision
14 requiring a circulator of a citizen's initiative or people's veto petition to be
15 a resident of Maine and a registered voter in Maine, requirements that have
16 been ruled unconstitutional in federal court?" '

17

Amend the resolution by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
18 section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the question of the referendum to specify that the provisions
21 of the Constitution of Maine being removed have been found to be unconstitutional by a
22 federal court
