COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to HP 958, L D 1503, "An Act Regarding State Court Remedies for Violations of Legal or Constitutional Rights by Federal Employees"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §7 by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 1, lines 21 to 24 in L D)

Amend the bill in section 1 in §7 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment removes from the bill provisions directing the process that is to be followed by the Maine Judicial Branch in an action against a federal employee pursuant to this legislation
