SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, replaces the bill with a resolve As in the bill, the resolve directs the Department of Education to provide giants to school administrative units to promote innovative learning strategies to address student achievement gaps. In awarding grants, the department must give special consideration to school administrative units that demonstrate instructional partnerships with professional organizations or companies and partnerships with institutions of higher education and that provide specific data on closing the achievement gap for economically disadvantaged students, racial and ethnic populations and students whose learning achievements were negatively affected due to COVID-19 pandemic restrictions. The bill appropriates \$2,000,000 in fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 to provide such giants
