

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
3 allocations are made.

4 **PUBLIC SAFETY, DEPARTMENT OF**

5 **Emergency Medical Services 0485**

6 Initiative: Provides appropriations to support existing transportation costs of emergency
7 medical services. These appropriations must be reduced to the maximum extent possible
8 through the use of public and private Medicaid match programs.

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill provides General Fund appropriations to the Department of Public Safety to
15 support existing transportation costs of emergency medical services. These appropriations
16 must be reduced to the maximum extent possible through the use of public and private
17 Medicaid match programs.
