1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Community school application, procedures and criteria. By October
1, 2023, the Department of Education shall develop an application process, procedures and
criteria for implementing the requirements for designation of community schools pursuant
to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 333. The department shall adopt rules
to implement this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules
as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
