### SUMMARY

17 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment changes the 18 applicability date for the requirements in the bill to be incorporated into health plans to 19 those health plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2025. The amendment makes 20 changes to remove unnecessary language and adds a provision to make the requirements 21 applicable to nonprofit hospital or health service organizations by cross-reference in place 22 of substantive language.

The amendment also adds an appropriation to provide ongoing funding for the costs of
the benefit mandate defrayal required by federal law.

### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill requires carriers offering health plans in this State to provide coverage, including coverage in the MaineCare program, for biomarker testing. The requirements of the bill apply to health plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2025. The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services of \$170,000 for the estimated cost to reimburse insurance carriers for 6 months of the State's defrayal cost of this new mandate. The mandate will go into effect on all health insurance plans on the marketplace beginning January 1, 2025 and is estimated to cost \$340,000 annually thereafter.

The State Employee Health Plan's first impacted plan year will be SFY 2026 and is estimated to cost \$43,335 annually thereafter. The costs are split across the General Fund (\$19,565), Highway Funds (\$7,221) and all other funds (\$16,549).
