COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

"Do you favor adopting the Interstate Compact: Agreement Among the States to Elect the President of the United States by National Popular Vote, under which all of a participating state's electoral votes are awarded to the presidential slate that receives the most popular votes in all 50 states and the District of Columbia, except that the compact takes effect only when the number of electoral votes held by the participating states equals a majority of the overall total number of electoral votes, which is at least 270 of the 538 total electoral votes?"

The legal voters of each city, town and plantation shall vote by ballot on this question and designate their choice by a cross or check mark placed within a corresponding square below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots must be received, sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation meetings and returns made to the Secretary of State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor shall review the returns. If a majority of the legal votes are cast in favor of this Act, the Governor shall proclaim the result without delay and this Act becomes effective 30 days after the date of the proclamation.

The Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation all ballots, returns and copies of this Act necessary to carry out the purposes of this referendum.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

22 SUMMARY

This amendment removes provisions of the bill related to batch elimination, which were repealed in Public Law 2023, chapter 304, and makes an additional technical correction. It also removes the provision of the bill requiring the Governor to send a separate certificate of determination of the electors containing the names of the electors to the Archivist of the United States under state seal and instead requires only the one certificate of determination, which must contain the names of the electors and the statewide number of votes for each presidential slate that received votes in the final round of the presidential vote counting process, to be sent. The amendment also adds a referendum provision in order to send this Act to the voters of the State for acceptance or rejection at a statewide election held in the month of November following the passage of this Act.

The Secretary of State's budget includes sufficient funds to accommodate one ballot of average length for the general

election in November. If the number or size of the referendum questions requires production and delivery of a second ballot, an additional appropriation of \$266,000 may be required.
