COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 1024, L D 1579, "RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Eliminate the Diversion of
Revenue from Professional and Occupational Licensing Fees"

Amend the resolution in the 2nd paragraph in §26 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 7 in L D)
by striking out the following "must be expended" and inserting the following 'collected
and received by the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, or any successor
agency responsible for professional and occupational licensing, must be expended by the
Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, or any successor agency.'

Amend the resolution in the question in the 2nd line (page 1, line 17 in L D) by
inserting after the following: "fees" the following 'by the Department of Professional and
Financial Regulation'

Amend the resolution by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment narrows the scope of the constitutional resolution to funds received
or recovered by the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, or successor
agency, from professional and occupational licensing fees
