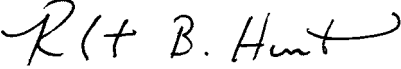

Certain Motor Vehicles Less than 3 Years Old**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRS §1751, sub-§1-A** is enacted to read:

3 **1-A. Exception; Class C motor vehicles.** Notwithstanding subsection 1, a motor
4 vehicle that a holder of a Class C license is authorized to operate pursuant to section 1252,
5 subsection 1, paragraph C is not required to have an inspection until 3 years from the last
6 day of the month in which it was manufactured.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill provides that a motor vehicle that a holder of a Class C license is authorized
9 to operate is not required to have an inspection until 3 years from the last day of the month
10 in which it was manufactured.
