This amendment changes 2 ongoing positions to one limited period position beginning November 1, 2023 and ending June 7, 2025. The General Fund appropriations are reduced from \$169,000 to \$56,878 in fiscal year 2023-24 and from \$174,248 to \$87,151 in fiscal year 2024-25.
