### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

 **Sec. 1. Report.** The Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry shall submit a report, no later than December 6, 2023, to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry on how the money appropriated under section 2 was spent. The department shall require Preble Street Food Security Hub to report to the department how the money it received under section 2 was spent as a condition of receiving the contract.

**Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

### AGRICULTURE, CONSERVATION AND FORESTRY, DEPARTMENT OF

#### Fund to Address Food Insecurity and Provide Nutrition Incentives Z329

Initiative: Provides one-time funding to contract with Preble Street Food Security Hub to help address food insecurity throughout the State.
