1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §317-B is enacted to read:
3	§317-B. Contracts and legislation
4 5	In addition to the other reports required under this chapter, a lobbyist shall file the following reports with the commission.
6 7 8	<b>1. Contracts.</b> Within 48 hours of entering into an agreement with another person for the purpose of lobbying for that person, a lobbyist shall file a report with the commission, on a form specified by the commission, disclosing the employment agreement.
9 10 11 12	<b>2. Legislation.</b> A lobbyist who engages in lobbying of the Legislature shall, no later than noon each Friday when the Legislature is in session, file a report with the commission, on a form specified by the commission, detailing each legislative instrument or action on which the lobbyist spent any time lobbying.
13 14 15 16	<b>3.</b> State agencies. A lobbyist who engages in lobbying of a state agency shall, no later than noon each Friday, file a report with the commission, on a form specified by the commission, detailing each issue before a state agency on which the lobbyist spent any time lobbying.
17	SUMMARY
18 19	This bill requires a lobbyist to file the following reports with the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices:
20 21	1. Within 48 hours of entering into an agreement with another person for the purpose of lobbying for that person, a report disclosing the employment agreement;
22 23	2. No later than noon each Friday when the Legislature is in session, a report detailing each legislative instrument or action on which the lobbyist spent any time lobbying; and
24 25	3. No later than noon each Friday, a report detailing each issue before a state agency on which the lobbyist spent any time lobbying.
