Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

All individual and group health maintenance organization policies and contracts must provide coverage for BRCA-related genetic counseling and BRCA-related genetic testing for individuals who are at increased risk for developing BRCA-related cancers according to the most recently published BRCA-related genetic counseling and BRCA-related genetic testing guidelines of a national cancer society.
- 3. Prohibition of cost-sharing. A health maintenance organization may not impose a deductible, copayment, coinsurance or other cost-sharing requirement for the costs of BRCA-related genetic testing or BRCA-related genetic counseling.
- **Sec. 7. Application.** This Act applies to all policies, contracts and certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State on or after January 1, 2024. For purposes of this Act, all contracts are deemed to be renewed no later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date.

l	SUMMARY
2	This bill requires that individual and group health insurance policies provide coverage
3	for BRCA-related genetic counseling and BRCA-related genetic testing for individuals
4	who are at increased risk for developing BRCA-related cancers. The requirements apply to
5	insurance policies beginning on January 1, 2024.
