COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to HP 1078, L D 1679, "An Act Regarding the Maine Indian Tribal-State Commission"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following

'Sec. 2. Staggered terms. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30, section 6212, subsection 1, for the first 6 appointments to the Maine Indian Tribal-State Commission made after the effective date of this Act, the Governor shall appoint 2 members for a term of 2 years, 2 members for a term of 3 years and 2 members for a term of 4 years All subsequent appointments by the Governor to the commission are subject to Title 30, section 6212, subsection 1 '

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is a minority report of the committee, revises the provision of the bill establishing staggered terms for the members of the Maine Indian Tribal-State Commission appointed by the Governor Under the amendment, of the first 6 commission members appointed by the Governor after the effective date of this legislation, 2 members must be appointed for a term of 2 years, 2 members must be appointed for a term of 3 years and 2 members must be appointed for a term of 4 years All subsequent appointments by the Governor to the commission are for 3 years as specified in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30, section 6212, subsection 1
