8 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1083, L.D. 1684, "An Act to Invest in the  
9 Health and Wellness of Older Maine Residents by Expanding Coordinated Community

11 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

12 'Resolve, to Invest in the Health and Wellness of Older Maine Residents by  
13 Implementing a Pilot Program to Expand Coordinated Community Programming'

14 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following:

15 'Sec. 1. Department to implement navigation and case management pilot  
16 program. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall  
17 implement a pilot program to provide navigation and case management services to older  
18 adults in accordance with the requirements of the federal 1987 Older Americans Act, 42  
19 United States Code, as amended. The pilot program must fund a single case manager  
20 position at an aging and disability resource center. The pilot program ends September 30,  
21 2025.

22 Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following  
23 appropriations and allocations are made.

24 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF  
25 Office of Aging and Disability Services Central Office 0140

26 Initiative: Provides one-time funding to implement a pilot program to provide navigation  
27 and case management services to older adults in accordance with the requirements of the  
28 federal 1987 Older Americans Act, 42 United States Code, as amended. The pilot program  
29 must fund a single case manager position at an aging and disability resource center. The  
30 pilot program ends September 30, 2025.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the ongoing General Fund appropriation to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$2,500,000 beginning in fiscal year 2023-24 to develop interventions and deliver navigation and case management services for older adults in each of Maine's coordinated community program areas and replaces it with a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$100,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 for a pilot program that ends September 30th, 2025.
