1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§105-A** is enacted to read:

3 **105-A. Pet medications.** Beginning January 1, 2024, sales of medications for pets  
4 sold on a doctor's prescription.

5 **SUMMARY**

6 This bill establishes an exemption from the sales and use tax for medications for pets  
7 sold on a doctor's prescription.
