COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 1091, L D 1702, "Resolve, to Establish the Commission to Improve the Educational Experience of People Who Are Resettling in Maine"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 5 in L D) by striking out the following. "16" and inserting the following: '17'

Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 5 in the first line (page 1, line 40 in L D) by striking out the following "Three" and inserting the following. 'Four'

Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 5 by striking out all of paragraph A (page 2, lines 1 and 2 in L D) and inserting the following

'A One member who is an adult education teacher in a public school in the State, selected from a list of nominees provided by a statewide labor organization representing teachers,'

Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 5 in paragraph B in the last line (page 2, line 5 in L D) by striking out the following ", and" and inserting the following ','

Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 5 by inserting after paragraph C the following

'D One member who is an education administrator, and'

Amend the resolve in section 7 in the first line (page 2, line 32 in L D) by striking out the following "no later than December 6, 2023" and inserting the following 'notwithstanding Joint Rule 353, no later than January 3, 2024'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

Legislative Cost/Study

The general operating expenses of this study are projected to be \$3,050 in fiscal year 2023-24. The Legislature's proposed budget for the 2024-2025 biennium includes \$14,500 in each of fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 for the costs of legislative studies, as well as \$2,234 in projected balances from fiscal year 2022-23 and \$36,777 of balances carried over from prior years for this purpose. Whether these amounts are sufficient to fund all studies will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature. The additional costs of providing staffing assistance to the study during the interim can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted staff resources.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Additional costs to the Department of Education associated with the commissioner or the commissioner's designee serving on the commission can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
