1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4364-C, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 672, §7, is
amended to read:

2. Municipalities may regulate short-term rentals. A municipality may establish and enforce regulations regarding short-term rental units in order to achieve the statewide or regional housing production goal. For the purposes of this subsection, "short-term rental unit" means living quarters offered for rental through a transient rental platform as defined by Title 36, section 1752, subsection 20-C and living quarters governed by other law, including, but not limited to, Title 22, section 2501.

10 SUMMARY

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11 This bill changes the definition of "short-term rental unit" in the laws that allow a 12 municipality to establish and enforce regulations regarding short-term rental units in order 13 to achieve the statewide or regional housing production goal by including certain living 14 quarters that are not required to be licensed under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, 15 chapter 562.
