COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to HP 1118, LD 1739, "An Act to Extend Development District Tax Increment Financing Districts"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subparagraph (1) in the 4th line (page 1, line 7 in LD) by inserting after the following "that" the following 'during the 10 calendar years after the general effective date of laws enacted during the First Special Session of the 131st Legislature.'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subparagraph (1) in the 5th line (page 1, line 8 in LD) by striking out the following "30" and inserting the following '20'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subparagraph (1) in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 8 and 9 in LD) by striking out the following "51% of state tax increment" and inserting the following '75% of tax increment financing'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to HP 1118, LD 1739

1 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
2 number to read consecutively

3 **SUMMARY**

4 This amendment provides that additional extensions of development districts that are
5 tax increment financing districts may be authorized only during the 10 calendar years after
6 the general effective date of laws enacted during the First Special Session of the 131st
7 Legislature, changes the authorized period of extension from 30 years to 20 years and
8 changes the condition for permitting extensions to require that the district must use at least
9 75% of the tax increment financing revenue for affordable housing projects or transit-
10 oriented development. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations totaling \$150,115 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$116,820 in fiscal year 2024-25 to the Business Development program within the Department of Economic and Community Development for one Development Program Officer position and related All Other costs to support an anticipated increase in workload due to the expansion of the tax increment financing program. Of these amounts, \$75,115 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$96,820 in fiscal year 2024-25 is required to support the cost of the position and \$75,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 and \$20,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 is required to support the cost of anticipated changes that will need to be made to the department's electronic database.
