3	§42-D. Poster of veterans' benefits and services
4 5 6	1. Poster. The bureau shall consult with the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management, Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services to create and distribute a veterans' benefits and services poster.
7 8	2. Details. The poster under this section must include, at a minimum, information regarding the following:
9 10 11	A. Contact and website information for the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management, Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services and services for veterans provided by that bureau;
12	B. Substance use and mental health treatment services;
13	C. Educational, workforce and training resources;
14	D. Tax benefits;
15	E. Obtaining driver's licenses and nondriver identification cards;
16	F. Eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits under state and federal law;
17	G. Legal services; and
18 19	H. Contact information for the United States Department of Veterans Affairs Veterans Crisis Line.
20 21 22	3. Employer shall post. An employer with more than 50 full-time equivalent employees shall display the poster under this section in a conspicuous place accessible to employees in the workplace.

24 25 26	This bill requires the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards to create and distribute a poster describing veterans' benefits and services in workplaces of more than 50 full-time equivalent employees.
