**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §408-A, sub-§8, ¶B,** as amended by PL 2021, c. 375, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (1) to read:

(1) The agency or official may ~~not~~ charge a fee of \$25 for the first 2 hours of staff time per request.

**Sec. 2. 1 MRSA §408-A, sub-§8, ¶B,** as amended by PL 2021, c. 375, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (2) to read:

(2) After the first 2 hours of staff time, the agency or official may charge a fee of ~~not more than~~ \$25 per hour.

**SUMMARY**

This bill allows a state agency or official to charge \$25 for the first 2 hours of staff time responding to a public records request under the Freedom of Access Act and sets the fee at \$25 per hour for staff time after the first 2 hours.
