COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 722, LD 1797, "An Act to Expand Maine's Health Care Workforce by Expanding Educational Opportunities and Providing Tax Credits"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following
'An Act to Expand Maine's Health Care Workforce by Expanding Educational Opportunities'

Amend the bill in section 3 in c 279 in §1700-H in subsection 3 by inserting after paragraph G the following

'As used in this subsection, "rural" means areas in the State that are designated as health professional shortage areas or medically underserved areas or that contain a medically underserved population as defined by the federal Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration.'

Amend the bill in section 3 in c 279 in §1700-H by inserting after subsection 4 the following

'5 Repeal; funds lapse to General Fund This section is repealed January 1, 2026 All funds in the fund on January 1, 2026 lapse to the General Fund'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 4 and 5 and inserting the following
'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made

SUMMARY

This amendment does the following

1 It provides for \$1,000,000 appropriations in fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 to the nursing education loan repayment program

2 It establishes the Maine Health Care Education Training and Medical Residency Fund as a 2-year pilot program and appropriates \$2,500,000 in fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 to the fund to establish clinical training opportunities for 3rd-year and 4th-year medical students in the rural parts of the State

3 It provides for \$2,000,000 appropriations in fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 to the Maine Health Care Provider Loan Repayment Program Fund

4 It provides for \$1,000,000 appropriations in fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 to the Doctors for Maine's Future Scholarship Fund

5 It removes from the bill the new income tax credit of up to \$500 a year for new nurses, for 3 years per eligible nurse, for employment in a licensed health care facility in the State

6 It removes from the bill the \$300,000 in ongoing annual appropriations to support incentives for clinical preceptorships

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes one-time General Fund appropriations totaling \$4,000,000 per year in fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 only to the Finance Authority of Maine. Of that amount, \$1,000,000 per year is provided for the Doctor's for Maine's Future Scholarship Fund, \$2,000,000 per year is provided for the Maine Health Care Provider Loan Repayment Program Fund and \$1,000,000 per year is provided for the Nursing Education Loan Repayment Program.

This bill also includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$2,500,000 per year in fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 for the Maine Medical Education Training and Residency Fund.
