## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3151, sub-\$4, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 73

- **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3151, sub-§4,** as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C, §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:
- **4. Volunteer firefighter.** "Volunteer firefighter" means an active member of a volunteer fire association or a volunteer fire department created by a municipality who receives no compensation from the municipality other than up to 20% of the compensation of a municipal firefighter and may receive injury and death benefits.

9 SUMMARY

 The current definition of "volunteer firefighter" provides that the firefighter receives no compensation and must belong to a volunteer fire association. This bill changes that definition to provide that the firefighter receives up to 20% of the compensation of a municipal firefighter and may belong to a volunteer fire department created by a municipality.
