COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 728, L D 1803, "An Act to Improve the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §105 in subsection 3 in the 5th and 6th lines (page 2, lines 1 and 2 in L D) by striking out the following "a worker or person, as defined in section 105-A, subsection 1, paragraph" and inserting the following 'as defined in section 105-A, subsection 1, paragraph'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §105 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 2, line 4 in L D) by striking out the following "E, who has" and inserting the following 'independent contractor and construction subcontractor statements'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §105 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 2, line 4 in L D) by striking out the following "a statement"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Workers' Compensation Board to post on its publicly accessible website information pertaining to independent contractor and construction subcontractor statements filed with the board
