Sec. 1. State to reimburse for passenger rail service for one month.
Resolved: That the Department of Administrative and Financial Services shall reimburse
residents of the State for the cost of traveling on passenger rail service provided by the
National Railroad Passenger Corporation, doing business as Amtrak, within the State
during the period from December 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023. The department shall
adopt rules to implement this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine
technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter
2-A.

9 SUMMARY

 This bill directs the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to reimburse residents of the State for the cost of traveling on passenger rail service provided by Amtrak, within the State during the period from December 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.
