HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 1187,
LD 1857, "An Act to Create the Public Safety Health and Wellness Reimbursement Fund
to Benefit Public Safety Workers and Volunteers"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting the following

'Sec. 4. Administration costs. Resolved: That the Department of Public Safety
may use up to 10% of the grant funding to administer the grant'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively

This amendment removes the 5% limitation on administration costs for grant recipients
and adds a 10% limitation on administration costs for the grant program as administered
by the Department of Public Safety
