19 20		As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.				
21 22		1. Fund. "Fund" means the Community Housing Production Fund established in section 4769.				
23 24		2. Program. "Program" means the Community Housing Production Program established in section 4770.				
25		3. State authority. "State authority" means the Maine State Housing Authority.				
26		§4769. Community Housing Production Fund				
27 28		1. Establishment. The Community Housing Production Fund is established under the jurisdiction of the Maine State Housing Authority.				
29		2. Sources of fund. The following must be paid into the fund:				
30		A. All money appropriated for inclusion in the fund;

Money in the fund may be deposited with the state authority to the credit of the fund or may be invested as provided by law. The following may be used to pay the administrative costs of the program:
9	A. No more than 10% of the money in the fund; and
10	B. Any earnings on money in the fund.
11 12	4. Accounts within fund. The state authority may divide money in the fund into separate accounts determined necessary or convenient for carrying out this subchapter.
13 14	5. Nonlapsing fund. The fund is a nonlapsing fund. All money in the fund must be continuously applied by the state authority to carry out this subchapter.
15	§4770. Community Housing Production Program
16 17	The Community Housing Production Program is established for the purpose of providing grants for the production of mixed-income rental housing.
18 19 20	1. Operation. The state authority shall administer the program. The program may be operated in conjunction with other programs of the state authority to achieve the purpose of this subchapter.
21 22 23 24 25 26 27	2. Uses of fund. Money in the fund may be used to meet the purposes of the program in the form of grants to developers incorporated as nonprofit organizations, housing cooperatives, municipalities or other public entities for the production of mixed-income rental housing for individuals with incomes up to 120% of the area median income as determined by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. The state authority may establish limits from time to time on the amount of grants to applicants to maintain a minimum balance in the fund.
28 29 30	3. Provisions governing grants. The program must be administered pursuant to this section and give priority to projects that commit to maintain housing affordable to individuals with low income as described in this subsection.
31 32 33	A. The state authority, by routine technical rules adopted in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, shall establish criteria for the awarding of grants to qualified applicants.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes one-time General Fund appropriations totaling \$100,000,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 to the Maine State Housing Authority (MSHA) to support the production of mixed income housing and existing home ownership assistance programs. Of that amount, \$75,000,000 is appropriated on a one-time basis to a newly established Community Housing Production Fund program for grants to non-profit developers, cooperatives and public entities for the production of mixed income housing and \$25,000,000 is appropriated on a one-time basis to the Housing Authority - State program to support existing home ownership assistance programs. According to MSHA, it will be able to implement the requirements of this legislation within existing budgeted resources and will not need to utilize a percentage of the monies in the Community Housing Production Fund program to support its administrative costs.
