1       **Sec. 1. Brooks named. Resolved:** That the Department of Administrative and  
2 Financial Services, Office of Information Technology, Office of Geographic Information  
3 Systems shall name the following brooks and provide a recommendation about the naming  
4 of the brooks to the United States Department of the Interior, United States Geologic  
5 Survey, United States Board on Geographic Names:

6           1. The brook in the Town of Orient, Aroostook County, that flows under Boundary  
7 Road and into MacAllister Cove of Grand Lake is the Calais Bound Brook; and

8           2. The brook in the Town of Orient, Aroostook County, that flows under Boundary  
9 Road and Route 1, towards Skagrock Brook is the Bangor Bound Brook.

10   **SUMMARY**

11           This resolve requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Office  
12 of Information Technology, Office of Geographic Information Systems to name 2 brooks  
13 in the Town of Orient.
