1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 39-A MRSA §205, sub-§10 is enacted to read:
3	10. Inflation adjustment. Compensation under this Act must be annually increased
4	to account for inflation by the amount of increase in the Consumer Price Index compiled
5	by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for the most recent
6	<u>12-month period for which data are available.</u>
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill requires benefits awarded under the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of
9	1992 to be annually increased to account for inflation by the amount of increase in the
10	Consumer Price Index compiled by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of
11	Labor Statistics.
