An Act to Improve Public Roadways on Unbridged Islands Not Served by the Maine State Ferry Service

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §710 is enacted to read:

§710. Island Road Maintenance Fund

- 1. Fund established. The Island Road Maintenance Fund, referred to in this section as "the fund," is established as a nonlapsing fund in the Department of Transportation.
- 2. Use of funds. Money deposited in the fund may be used by the Department of Transportation to provide grants to support public road maintenance for inhabited, unbridged island municipalities that are not served by the Maine State Ferry Service.
- 3. Source of funds. Money deposited in the fund includes, but is not limited to, revenue appropriated to the fund. The fund may accept funds from other sources.
 - **4. Limit.** The balance in the fund may not exceed \$5,000,000.
- 5. Rules. The Department of Transportation shall adopt routine technical rules as described in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A governing the making of grants from the fund to qualifying municipalities, with applications reviewed at least once annually. The rules must provide that, when considering grant applications, the department must give preference to projects on islands that have a limited property tax base to support maintenance of public roads and projects that seek or have been granted funds from the Federal Government.
- **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

This bill establishes the Island Road Maintenance Fund in the Department of Transportation to support public road maintenance for inhabited, unbridged island municipalities that are not served by the Maine State Ferry Service.
