1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1253-A** is enacted to read:

3 **§1253-A. Commercial driver's licenses within the State; exception**

4 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Secretary of State shall  
5 establish a commercial driver's license for use only within the State in accordance with this  
6 section.

7 **1. Requirements.** The holder of a commercial driver's license issued pursuant to this  
8 section must comply with all of the requirements of section 1253, except that the Secretary  
9 of State may not deny a person a commercial driver's license under this section on the basis  
10 of the person's authorized use of cannabis pursuant to Title 22, chapter 558-C or Title 28-B.  
11 This section may not be construed to authorize a person to use cannabis while operating a  
12 motor vehicle.

13 **2. Exception.** A person may not obtain a commercial driver's license pursuant to this  
14 section for the operation of a school bus.

15 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill establishes a commercial driver's license for use only within the State and  
17 prohibits the Secretary of State from denying a person that commercial driver's license on  
18 the basis of the person's authorized use of cannabis. The bill clarifies that the prohibition  
19 on denying a commercial driver's license may not to be construed as authorizing a person  
20 to use cannabis while operating a motor vehicle. The bill provides that a person may not  
21 obtain the commercial driver's license for the operation of a school bus.
