Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment replaces the bill's 3 ongoing Environmental Specialist III positions in the Department of Environmental Protection with 3 limited-period Environmental Specialist III positions that begin January 1, 2024 and end June 15, 2025. The General Fund appropriations are reduced by \$73,991 to \$138,146 in fiscal year 2023-24 and remain at \$293,502 in fiscal year 2024-25. The ongoing General Fund revenue loss continues to be \$2,800,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 2025-26.
