Preamble. The Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 23 requires that real estate
held by the State for conservation or recreation purposes may not be reduced or its uses
substantially altered except on the vote of 2/3 of all members elected to each House.

4 **Whereas**, certain real estate authorized for conveyance by this resolve is under the 5 designations described in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 598-A; and

6 **Whereas,** the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of 7 Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry may exchange interest in lands with the approval 8 of the Legislature in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 6209 and 9 Title 12, sections 1814, 1837 and 1851; now, therefore, be it

10 Sec. 1. Director of Bureau of Parks and Lands authorized to convey certain 11 interests in land in Piscataquis County. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau 12 of Parks and Lands within the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry may 13 by quitclaim deed without covenant, on other terms and conditions as the director may 14 direct, exchange interest in land described on Map PI054 Plan 01, Lot 1, in the Township 15 of Chesuncook for land of comparable market value described on Map PI054 Plan 02, Lot 16 32, in the Township of Chesuncook, all in Piscataquis County.
