2	Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §264, sub-§3, ¶S, as amended by PL 2023, c. 33, §2, is further
3	amended to read:
4	S. The South Portland Air National Guard Station, located on Western Avenue, South
5	Portland, by means of a quitclaim deed as long as the purchaser agrees to indemnify
6	and hold harmless the State from all claims, including any environmental clean-up
7	costs that may arise in connection with the land or the buildings constituting the station;

9	Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §264, sub-§3, ¶T, as enacted by PL 2023, c. 33, §3, is
10	amended to read:
11	T. The Houlton Armory, located at 86 Pleasant Street, Houlton, by means of a
12	quitclaim deed as long as the purchaser agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State
13	from all claims, including any environmental clean-up costs that may arise in
14	connection with the land or the buildings constituting the armory-; and
15	Sec. 3. 37-B MRSA §264, sub-§3, ¶U is enacted to read:
16	U. The Calais Armory, located at 53 Calais Avenue, Calais, by means of a quitclaim
17	deed as long as the purchaser agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State from all
18	claims, including any environmental clean-up costs that may arise in connection with
19	the land or the buildings constituting the armory.
