COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1302, L.D. 2040, "An Act to Restore the Board of Dental Practice's Authority to Issue Letters of Guidance"

Amend the bill by inserting before section 1 the following:

Sec. 1. 24 MRSA §2510, sub-§2-A, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 680, Pt. D, §4, is amended to read:

2-A. Confidentiality of letters of guidance or concern. Letters of guidance or concern issued by the board pursuant to Title 10, section 8003, subsection 5, paragraph E, or Title 32, section 18325, subsection 3 are not confidential.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24, section 2510, subsection 2-A includes a cross-reference to Title 10, section 8003, subsection 5, paragraph E, which previously governed the authority for the Board of Dental Practice to issue letters of guidance. This amendment adds a cross-reference to the provision of the bill that grants statutory authority of the Board of Dental Practice to issue letters of guidance.
