1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §1765, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 486, §3 and
3	affected by §6, is amended to read:
4	B. Serve Provide a notice upon with the information required under subsection 3 to
5	the person seeking registration, who shall then serve the notice on the other persons
6	named pursuant to subsection 1, paragraph C and provide them with an opportunity to
7	contest the registration in accordance with this section. Notice must be given in a
8	manner allowed under section 1738.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill shifts the burden of serving notice from a court in this State to the party
11	seeking the registration of a child custody determination of another state.
