Shutdown"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the substitute title (page 1, lines 12 and 13 in
amendment) the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd instructional paragraphs
(page 1, lines 14 to 18 in amendment).

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the **Whereas** paragraph (page 1, lines 19
to 22 in amendment).

Amend the amendment on page 3 by striking out all of the 3rd instructional paragraph
(page 3, lines 5 and 6) and inserting the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 4 and 5 and inserting the following:

Sec. 4. Additional transfer and allocation. The joint standing committee of the
Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs, after consultation
with the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health
coverage, insurance and financial services matters, may report out legislation to the First
Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature to address any funding needs of the Government
Shutdown Loan Guarantee Program established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10,
chapter 110, subchapter 15.

Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and
allocations are made.

Government Shutdown Loan Guarantee Program Fund N296

Initiative: Establishes the Government Shutdown Loan Guarantee Program Fund with a
\$250,000 transfer from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

5 Amend the amendment on page 3 by striking out all of section 5.

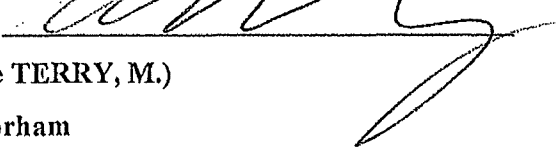
6 Amend the amendment on page 3 by inserting after section 5 the following:

7 'Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.'

8 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
9 section number to read consecutively.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to remove the emergency
12 preamble and emergency clause and shift funding from fiscal year 2023-24 to fiscal year
13 2024-25. It allows the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over
14 appropriations and financial affairs to report out legislation to the First Regular Session of
15 the 132nd Legislature rather than to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
