COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1357, L.D. 2133, "An Act to Expand the Use of Career and Technical Education Centers in the Development of the Electrician Workforce"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subparagraph (5) in the first line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "a" the following: '2-year'

Amend the bill in section 3 in subparagraph (5) in the 3rd line (page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2,000" and inserting the following: '6,000'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment amends the bill to clarify that an applicant for a journeyman-in-training electrician license may use course work from an approved 2-year secondary school career and technical education electrical program to qualify for the license examination. Additionally, the amendment increases the required number of work hours to be completed in the field for the journeyman-in-training license from at least 2,000 to at least 6,000 work hours.
