SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1359,  
L.D. 2135, "Resolve, to Investigate and Address Municipal Solid Waste Disposal Services  
Issues"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the last line (page  
2, line 29 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "1310-AA" the following: 'and  
the issuance of a decision by the Commissioner of Environmental Protection on that  
application pursuant to Title 38, section 1310-AA'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the first line (page  
2, line 38 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "operator" the following: 'by  
January 1, 2027'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to provide that the Department  
of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services may not execute an  
amendment to the operating services agreement concerning the operation of the state-  
owned Juniper Ridge Landfill in the City of Old Town unless it has not only submitted an  
application for a public benefit determination for a license for the expansion of that landfill  
but also received from the Commissioner of Environmental Protection a decision on that  
application. It also provides that the bureau must negotiate and execute an amendment to  
the operating services agreement that requires the operator by January 1, 2027 to implement  
and operate at the landfill the perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, or PFAS,  
treatment technologies, facilities or processes for landfill leachate as specified in the  
committee amendment.
