1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §90-H** is enacted to read:

3 **§90-H. Required training regarding harassment**

4 The Secretary of State shall attend and complete annually a course of in-person
5 education and training regarding harassment, including, but not limited to, sexual
6 harassment and racial harassment.

7 **Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §158** is enacted to read:

8 **§158. Required training regarding harassment**

9 The Treasurer of State shall attend and complete annually a course of in-person
10 education and training regarding harassment, including, but not limited to, sexual
11 harassment and racial harassment.

12 **Sec. 3. 5 MRSA §191, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

13 **5. Required training regarding harassment.** The Attorney General shall attend and
14 complete annually a course of in-person education and training regarding harassment,
15 including, but not limited to, sexual harassment and racial harassment.

16 **SUMMARY**

17 This bill requires the Secretary of State, Treasurer of State and Attorney General to
18 attend and complete annually a course of in-person education and training regarding
19 harassment, including, but not limited to, sexual harassment and racial harassment.

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
