Amend the bill in section 1 in §12002-D in the 2nd indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "chapter" the following: 'who are not otherwise compensated for their time serving on the board by their employer or the entity they represent'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §12002-D in the 2nd indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "compensated" the following: 'in an amount not to exceed the legislative per diem'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that only members not otherwise compensated for their duties on a board or commission are entitled to compensation and that the compensation may not exceed the legislative per diem.
