COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1383, L.D. 2157, "An Act to Prohibit Tobacco Sales near Schools"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1,000" and inserting the following: '500'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It prohibits the Department of Health and Human Services from issuing new or renewed retail tobacco licenses to a retailer located within 500 feet of a school rather than 1,000 feet as prohibited in the bill.
