11	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:
12	'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1552, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
13 14 15 16 17	1-A. Proximity to schools. Beginning April 1, 2025, the department may not issue a new retail tobacco license to a retailer located within 300 feet of a school in existence at the time the application for a new license is made. This subsection does not apply to a retailer in existence prior to April 1, 2025 that is applying to renew a retail tobacco license or is applying for a new license due to a transfer of ownership of the retail business.
18 19 20 21 22	For the purposes of this subsection, "school" includes a public school, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 24; a private school, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 22; a public preschool program, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 23-A; and any other educational facility that serves children from prekindergarten to grade 12.
23 24	Distance must be measured from the main entrance of the retailer's premises to the main entrance of the school by the ordinary course of travel.'
25 26	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
27	SUMMARY
28 29 30 31	This amendment is a minority report of the committee. This amendment prohibits the Department of Health and Human Services, beginning April 1, 2025, from issuing a new tobacco license to a retailer located within 300 feet of a school. The provision is not applicable to retailers that were in existence prior to April 1, 2025 that are applying to
