Grant program. The Department of Health and Human Services shall 18 develop a grant program for community-based organizations that provide career 19 exploration opportunities for youth of middle school and high school age. The department 20 shall develop a request for proposals that focuses on increasing physical space in the 21 community to increase the number of youth served, as well as improving the health, 22 well-being and academic success of youth and advancing social equity. The funding for 23 the program must be fully expended in fiscal year 2024-25 and may be awarded to a single 24 organization or multiple organizations, as long as the award process is competitive. The 25 department shall provide a report on how the funding was spent to the joint standing 26 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters 27 no later than January 1, 2026. 28 Sec. 2.
