1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4211, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	3-A. Temporary portable toilets. A person is not required to obtain a permit from a local plumbing inspector to place for use a temporary portable toilet. For purposes of this subsection, "temporary portable toilet" means a prefabricated toilet designed for temporary use.
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill specifies that a permit from a local plumbing inspector is not required for the placement for use of a temporary portable toilet.
