1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSА §4211, sub-§3-A** is enacted to read:

3 **3-A. Temporary portable toilets.** A person is not required to obtain a permit from a
4 local plumbing inspector to place for use a temporary portable toilet. For purposes of this
5 subsection, "temporary portable toilet" means a prefabricated toilet designed for temporary
6 use.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill specifies that a permit from a local plumbing inspector is not required for the
9 placement for use of a temporary portable toilet.
