Sec. UUUU-1. Ambulance services reimbursement rate. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 3174-JJ or any other provision of law to the contrary, beginning September 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2027, the Department of Health and Human Services shall reimburse for ambulance services under MaineCare at a level that is 140% of the average allowable reimbursement rate under Medicare for such services.

20 Sec. UUUU-2. Transfer from Department of Public Safety, Emergency 21 Medical Services Stabilization and Sustainability Program, Other Special Revenue Funds account; Department of Health and Human Services, Medical 22 Care - Payments to Providers. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, 23 on or before June 30, 2025, the State Controller shall transfer \$15,000,000 from the 24 25 Department of Public Safety, Emergency Medical Services Stabilization and Sustainability Program, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the Department of Health and Human 26 27 Services, Medical Care - Payments to Providers program, Other Special Revenue Funds 28 account.

Initiative: Provides one-time allocation for a temporary change to the department's rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 5, Ambulance Services, so that effective September 1, 2024, MaineCare ambulance services codes with Medicare equivalents are reimbursed at 140% of the current published Medicare rates. This temporary increase ends June 30, 2027.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment makes a temporary change to the Department of Health and Human Services' (DHHS) rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 5, Ambulance Services, so that effective July 1, 2024 MaineCare Ambulance Services codes with Medicare equivalents are reimbursed at 140% of the current published Medicare rates through June 30, 2027. This amendment includes Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$5,000,000 over 3 years to fund this temporary increase through June 30, 2027. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.

This amendment transfers \$15,000,000 from the Department of Public Safety (DPS), EMS Stabilization and Sustainability program, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the DHHS, Medical Care - Payments to Providers program. The funding is deallocated in DPS and allocated over 3 years in DHHS.
