UUUU-1. 21-A MRSA §611 is enacted to read: 15 16 §611. Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund 1. Fund established. The Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund, a 17 18 nonlapsing, interest-bearing account within the Department of the Secretary of State, 19 referred to in this section as "the fund," is established for the purpose of receiving funds 20 from the State to support the costs associated with the production and delivery of election 21 materials as required under this Title, including, but not limited to, ballots, absentee ballot 22 envelopes, voter registration applications, forms, instructions and other election supplies. 23 The use of funds from the fund is in addition to any funds received by the Department of 24 the Secretary of State from the State for this purpose. 25 2. Funding. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before 26 September 30, 2024, and every September 30th thereafter, the State Controller shall 27 transfer \$172,000 from the Medical Use of Cannabis Fund, established in Title 22, section 28 2430, to the Department of Secretary of State, Bureau of Administrative Services and 29 Corporations program, Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund Other Special 30 Revenue Funds account to support the costs associated with the production and delivery of 31 election materials pursuant to subsection 1, except that, beginning December 1, 2024, the 32 transfer amount must be adjusted every 2 years based on the Consumer Price Index as 33 reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics and rounded 34 to the nearest amount divisible by \$100. 35 3. Carry forward; transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State Controller shall carry forward any remaining balances in the Department 36 37 of Secretary of State, Bureau of Administrative Services and Corporations program, 38 General Fund account at the end of fiscal year 2024-25 and each fiscal year thereafter into

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment creates the Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds program within the Department of Secretary of State. It provides ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds allocations to the Department of Secretary of State of \$172,000 beginning in fiscal year 2024-25 to support costs associated with the production and delivery of election materials and provides annual transfers from the Medical Use of Cannabis Fund to the Fund of \$172,000 beginning in fiscal year 2024-25 to fund the election materials costs.
